Brush Up on Your Scout Skills

- Practice the Scout Oath, Law, Motto, and Slogan with your parent or guardian.
- With your parent or guardian, review the different parts of your uniform and what they mean.
- With your parent or guardian learn and/or practice the knots required for your next rank.
- Update your personal first aid kit with your parent or guardian.
- With your parent or guardian learn and/or practice proper first aid required for your next rank.
- Help your family prepare a favorite campout meal.

Continue Your Advancement

- If you have not completed your Bobcat, or current rank, work with your parent or guardian and your Den Leader to complete it.
- Review your handbook and choose the next Adventure for your rank that would like to complete with your family and Den.
- With your parent or guardian, complete the Cyber Chip award for your rank.
- (Arrow of Light) Research at least two troops in your area. Find out when and where they meet.

Be Involved with Your Pack

- With your parent or guardian, research an idea for a Pack or Den activity.
- (Webelos and Arrow of Light) With your Pack, participate in your District Camporall in October.
- Invite a friend to a den or pack the meeting/activity.
- Participate in a service project with your parent or guardian. Day of Service is November 7th.
- Ask your parents or guardian to post a scout picture letting people know how much you like Scouting.

Always Live the Scout Oath and Law

- Tell your parent or guardian what the Scout Oath and Law mean to you.
- Talk to your Den Leader and your family about how you can continue to do a Good Turn Daily during social distancing.
- Write a "Thank You" letter to your Teacher, Principal and Den leader.

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
