#### **EVENT ATTENDEE REGISTRATION**


- Same for Guests and Scouters


#### **PARKING**


#### **DROP OFF & PICK UP @ IROEC**


#### **IRVINE PARK**

#### **ADVENTURE EVENTS**

- All events will have an "Adventure Pass"
  - Pass available, Report & Activity time noted
  - Passes will be given out starting 60 min before Report time.
  - Youth will be allowed 1 pass at a time

### XOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

- Focus: Less time in lines, more opportunity to see and experience Scouting!
- Throughput allows, passes can be expanded.
